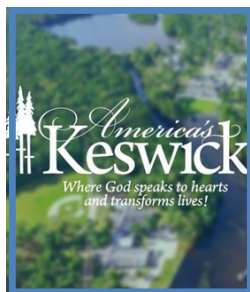
Love Your Church Sunday-April 30- after service. It is time for spring cleaning. There are many ways you can help us spruce up our church. Details to follow.
